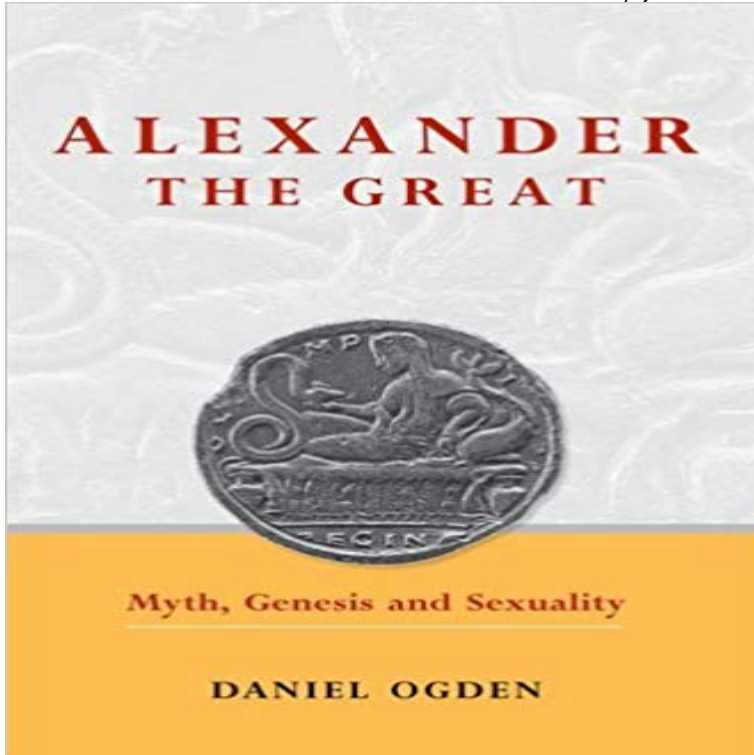


Alexander the Great: Myth, Genesis and Sexuality (University of Exeter Press - Exeter Studies in History)
