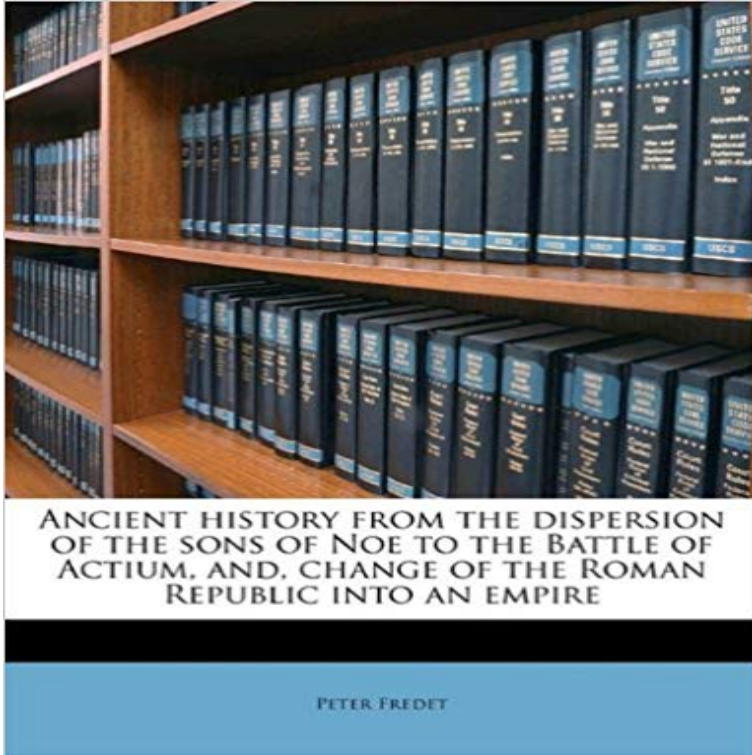


# Ancient history from the dispersion of the sons of Noe to the Battle of Actium, and, change of the Roman Republic into an empire
