


## Emotional Prisons - Origins (Volume 1)

Our prisons barbed wire is the messages that the world sends us, like you are not good enough. The armed guards are our friends and family who try to keep us trapped with their manipulation or coercion. We are firmly planted and sealed in our own unique and personal emotional prison. If what you have just read describes you or a person you care about, dont despair, there is hope! As surely as an individual can get into an emotional prison, he or she can get out. The Emotional Prisons series of books will help you to gain an understanding of what an emotional prison is, and what it looks and feels like. Just like a physical prison there is a door with a lock, and a person who has the key, his name is Jesus Christ. In this first book the author describes and explains
