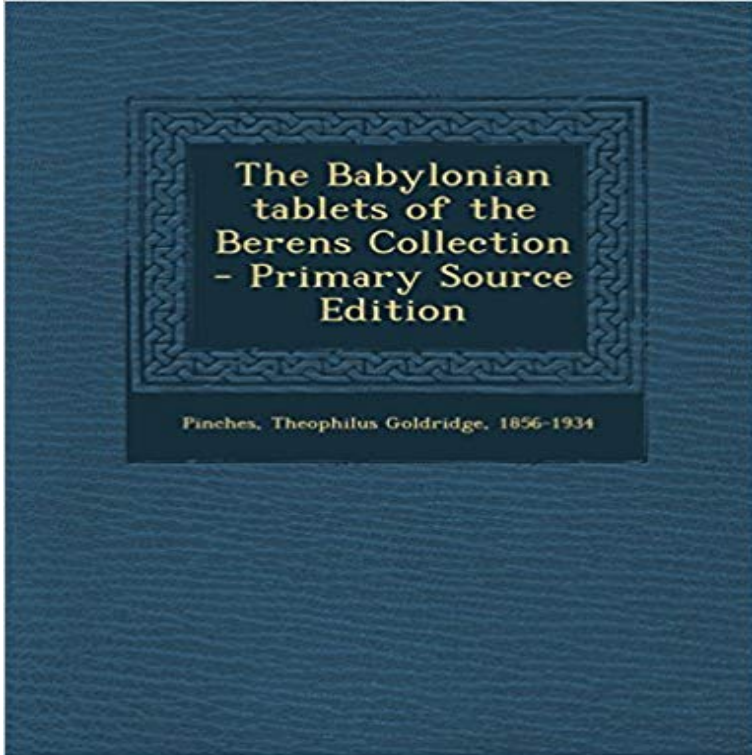


The Babylonian Tablets of the Berens Collection - Primary Source Edition (Akkadian Edition)
