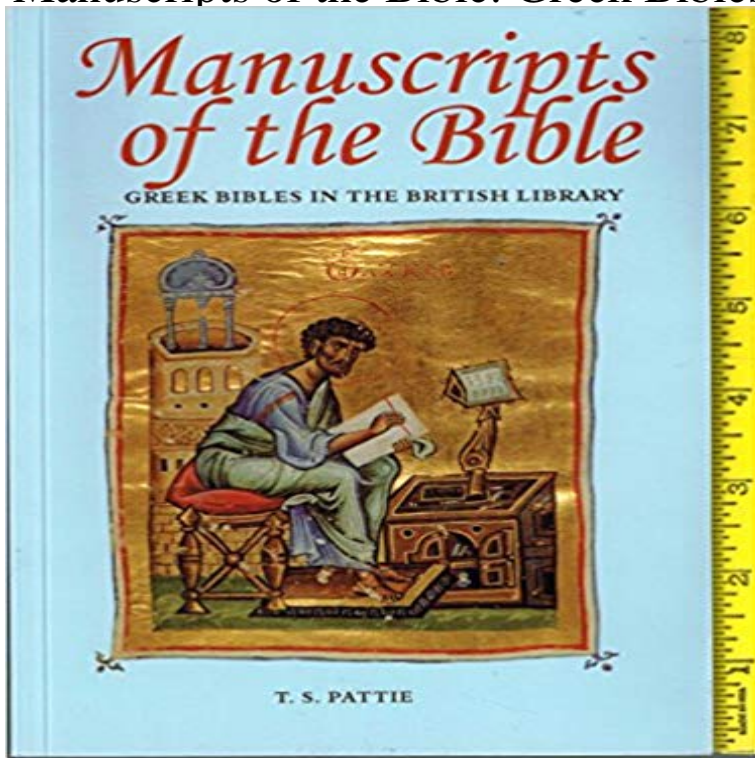


## Manuscripts of the Bible: Greek Bibles in the British Library
