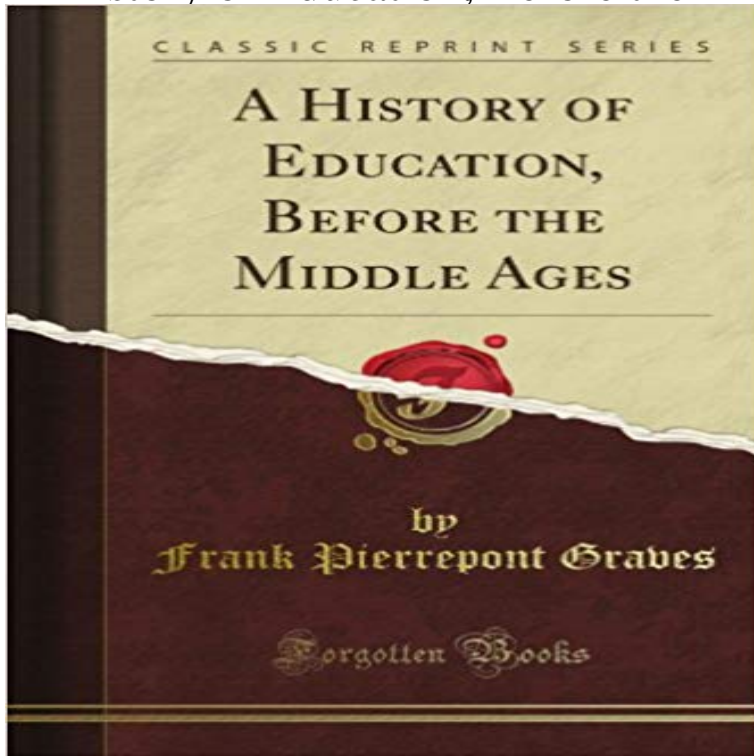


A History of Education, Before the Middle Ages (Classic Reprint)
