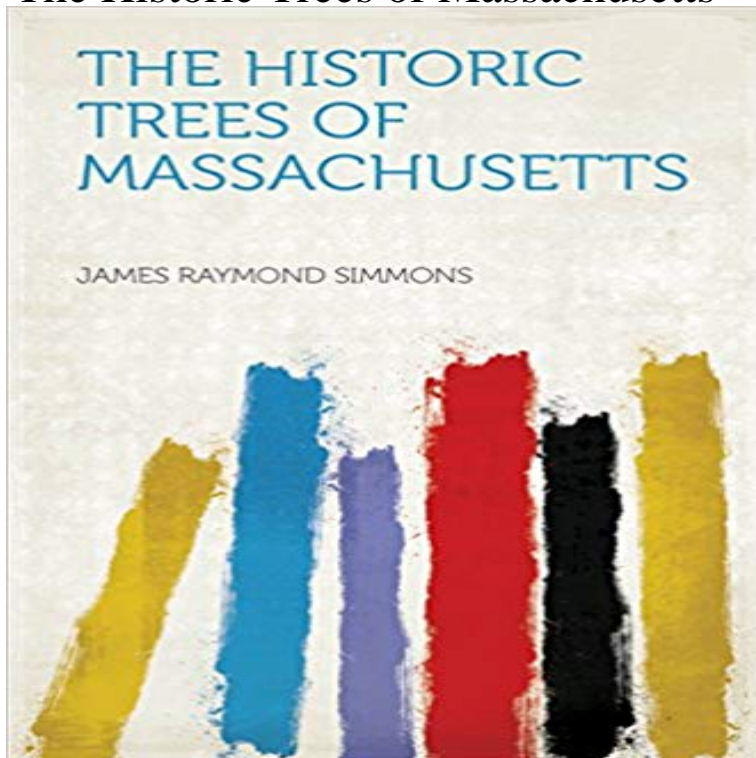


# The Historic Trees of Massachusetts
