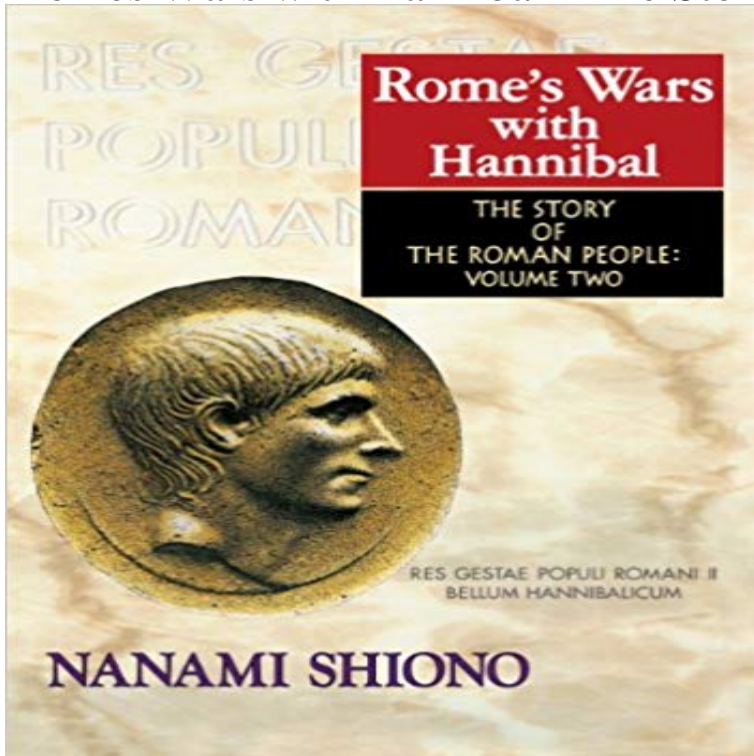


Romes Wars with Hannibal - The Story of the Roman People vol. II
