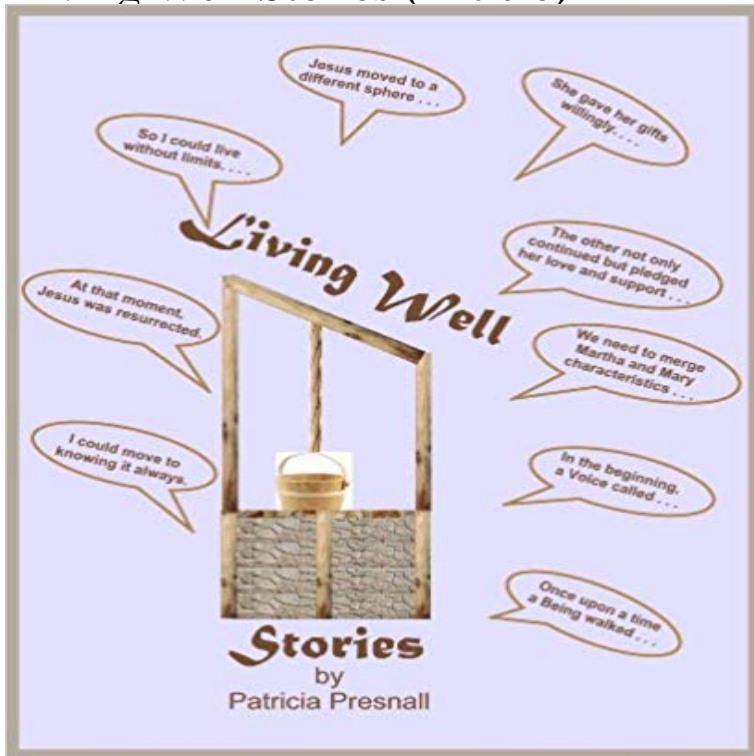


Living Well Stories (Article)
